Bedford Foundation, we are able to offer a **\$50 voucher** to military families who are currently active duty, reservists or retired. All military will count towards this program. Please download and complete the voucher for each child participating in either a class or camp at any of our seven locations and return it to the office when registering, in order to receive the \$50 off. Also, please submit a copy of your current military ID, along with the voucher. The voucher can be used repeatedly for each child throughout the year, as long as the funding remains available. Once the allotted funds are depleted, the program will end until renewal in the following year.

We are honored to have received this grant and award it back to you...our military families...so that your children can experience The First Tee! They can learn the game of golf, the Nine Core Values, Nine Healthy Habits and Life Skills to aid in their success both on and off the course!

- Through community outreach, we positively impacted over 38,000 children across the community; Homeschool programs at a YMCA, after school program at Boys & Girls Club or at military bases and through our National School Programs now in 86 elementary schools...we are bringing The First Tee to those who may not have the opportunity and introducing life skills and golf so every child has the chance to play.
